*Dear Friend,*

*Since 1955, God has touched the lives of thousands of boys through the Summer Camp ministry at Camp Hickory Hill. During this time he has used men and young men like you to serve Him on the Summer Camp Staff in a variety of ways. Please look over this letter and the application, and then pray about serving God at Hickory Hill this summer. I hope that God leads you to our team.*

## **SENIOR LEADERS:**

These adult volunteer positions vary greatly from weekend cook to soccer coach to maintenance helper to cabin leader. **Cabin counselors are especially needed.** We also need a couple more maintenance helpers.

As a Senior Leader, you will add the maturity that is necessary for our Summer Camp Team to be successful. Collegians, junior leaders and the service crew all play an important role in the summer camp program, but **the Senior Leaders will set the tone.** Senior Leaders add new ideas, bring a spark of enthusiasm and allow some leaders to have a needed break from cabin responsibilities. Senior Leaders are leaders not only to our campers, but to our staff as well.

**Please consider serving the Lord at Camp Hickory Hill for one week this summer.** The impact that you will have on boys and young men cannot be measured. Training and a detailed Staff Manual are available to you.

## **COLLEGIANS:**

Collegian is the term we use to describe our senior counselors who are in college or who will be entering college in the fall. A core of strong Collegians is necessary to generate a strong overall staff. **We are looking for strong Cabin Counselors and Activity Area Leaders as well.** Training is provided.

Each Collegian earns \$150 per week. (An opportunity exists to raise money to increase this amount. Information and assistance with support raising will be provided for those interested.)

## **JUNIOR LEADERS:**

Junior Leaders are high school aged young men that are returning to our counseling staff. **Junior Leaders fulfill an important mentoring roll to many of our campers.** Precamp is required for all Junior Leaders.

Each Junior Leader earns \$25 per week. (An opportunity exists to raise money to increase this amount. Information and assistance with support raising will be provided for those interested.)

### **LEADERS IN TRAINING:**

We are looking for committed Christian young men who have completed ninth grade. If you feel called by God to share your faith while working with boys and young men, then our Leader in Training program is for you.

The LIT program is designed to challenge you physically, mentally, socially and most of all spiritually. LIT is designed to facilitate the growth of young Christian leaders. We are looking for those who are willing to look into Scripture to see exactly what it means to be a Christian leader. We are also looking for those who have a desire to serve God by telling boys about Christ in a camp setting.

**Our training is completely Christ centered and will include** some Bible study preparation before arriving at camp, six days of training just for LIT's with a four day backpacking trip and four days of training with the rest of the camp staff.

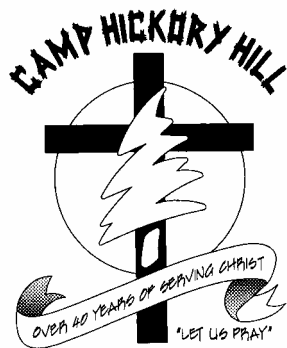
The cost of the training program is \$260. Those who successfully complete the training are asked to serve in at least three of the four full camper weeks. You will be given \$20 per week of service. ***You will not get rich financially, but the experience will be invaluable.*** (If money seems like an obstacle, please contact us.)

### **SERVICE CREW:**

We are looking for six teens (eighth grade graduates and up) each week to help with many of the projects around camp. The projects will range from painting a cabin, to taking out the garbage, mopping the shower house or setting up for a special with the program directors. Your schedule will vary every day, but it will always include a swim and a couple of hours off.

Service Crew members are required to be a camper for at least one week. (Exceptions must be cleared with the Summer Camp Director.) You may be on Service Crew for one or two weeks. There is no pay other than room and board, but **this position allows you the opportunity to work along side the Camp Hickory Hill Staff and to show them that you should be considered for the LIT program in another year.**

*I look forward to the summer staff team that God will provide, the campers he will bring us, the fun, the discipleship and the decisions for Him. **I hope that God is leading you to our team this summer.** Please complete an application and mail it to me right away. You should be able to fill it out in less than ten minutes. **Applications should be turned in by March 15.** If you have any questions, please contact me.
